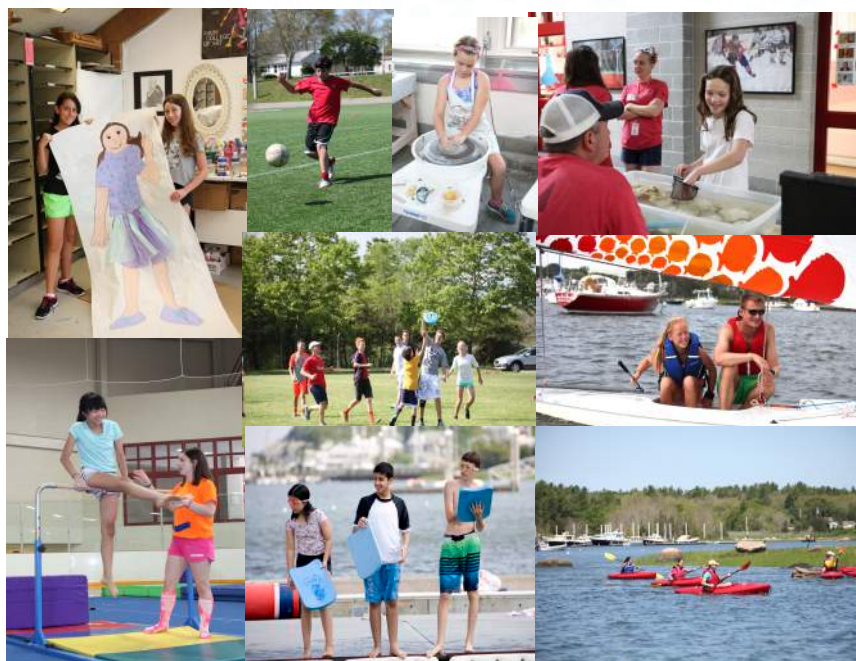

We know...summer can't come soon enough!

Try this fun family activity to help you pass the time away!

Construction Paper Winter Wreath

Materials:

- Ring of cardboard (empty cereal boxes work wonderfully)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Small piece of wool
- Stapler and tape (optional)

Instructions:

- Trace a small plate and a large plate onto a piece of old cardboard
- Empty cereal boxes or frozen dinner boxes work well as a source of recycled cardboard.
- Cut a small strip of cardboard and glue or tape it onto the back of the ring over any folds in the cardboard.
- This will reinforce the ring.
- Cut strips of construction paper (about 1 1/2 inches by 4 inches).
- Glue the strips into rolls (like making a paper chain).
- Glue the rolls of construction paper onto the wreath.
- For the center snowflake decoration, cut a small snowflake out of paper.
- Take a piece of string and tape it to the wreath and to the snowflake so the snowflake hangs in the center of the wreath

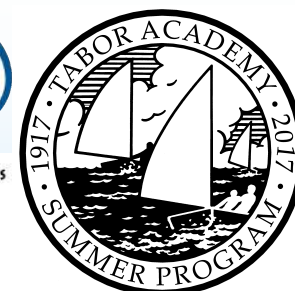
